Bill of Materials (BOM): To ensure compliance with the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) and approved sourcing policies, the company must provide a complete Bill of Materials (BOM) for DCMA scrutiny. The BOM must be in a human-readable format and adhere to the following requirements:

- **Content:** List all physical components with firmware or software (e.g., circuit boards, ICs, sensors), all sub-assemblies and assemblies must also be included even if no firmware or software is on the assembly i.e. dumb battery or dumb motors. Basic hardware without firmware (screws, resistors) can be excluded.
- **Structure:** Components must be tied to their respective sub-assemblies and final assemblies.
- **Data Points:**
 - **Component Level:** Specify the country of manufacture and specify the country of domicile, include **Software information** at this level as well.
 - **Assembly & Sub-Assembly Level:** note whether the assembly is available for purchase.

Instruction for completing the “Submit Your Product” Intake Form

Bill of Lading: Document(s) issued by a carrier to a shipper that details the type, quantity, and destination of the goods being carried. Bills of Lading serve as evidence of the supply chain's integrity and provide a verifiable record of where components have been sourced from and how they have been transported.

Company Capitalization Table: Often referred to as a "cap table," details the equity ownership of a company. Used to verify the ownership and control structure of the company, ensuring that it is not subject to foreign ownership, control, or influence (FOCI) that could pose a security risk.

Product Image: Multiple high-quality product images of the drone, controller, and packaging.

Specification Sheet: Technical document that outlines the performance characteristics, features, and capabilities of the platform or component. Will be used on the website after approval for end user information.
